The API for joint publications will have to be calculated in the following manner: Of the total score for the relevant category of publication by the concerned teacher, the first/Principal author and the corresponding author/supervisor/mentor of the teacher would share equally 60% of the total points and the remaining 40% would be shared equally by all other authors.
- 2. AICTE Regulation 2012 and/or Goa University's Regulations, Statutes and it's time to time amendments applicable to college shall be governed by the candidate at the time appointment.
- 3. Candidate must furnish information with evidence of documented proofs for verification.
- 4. Screening/selection committees will assess and verify the categorization and scores of API & publications claimed by the candidate based on evidence of documented proofs.
